

Claimant Erica Reed filed a petition for alternate medical care on December 28, 2018, alleging the defendants directed care to Dr. Neff, but had not approved timely treatment. An alternate care hearing was scheduled for January 10, 2019. The morning of the hearing the defendants agreed to authorize Dr. Neff to be the authorized treating physician for the claimant's left knee injury. Defendants reported Dr. Neff had provided the parties with an independent medical examination report that outlines his recommendations, the defendants have agreed to follow Dr. Neff's recommendations, and the defendants further agreed to contact Dr. Neff's office to schedule an appointment for the claimant with Dr. Neff at Dr. Neff's first availability. Defendants have agreed to the entry of this consent order.

Therefore, upon agreement of the parties, the defendants are ordered to provide the care requested in the petition for alternate medical care filed on December 28, 2018, namely to follow Dr. Neff's recommendations set forth in his report, and to schedule an appointment for the claimant with Dr. Neff at Dr. Neff's first availability.
