CONSENT ORDER

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Claimant filed a petition seeking alternate medical care on June 21, 2022. A telephonic hearing on this petition was scheduled to occur on July 1, 2022 at 10:30 A.M.


Prior to the alternate medical care hearing, the parties reached a resolution by consent. Defendants have confirmed that they have authorized claimant to be seen by an occupational medicine physician for evaluation of her alleged mental health symptoms. Defendants are currently attempting to schedule an appointment with occupational medicine. Defendants agree to schedule claimant to be seen by occupational medicine as soon as possible, but not later than July 15, 2022.

By reaching this agreement and consenting to this order, neither party waives any rights they may have in the future to address medical treatment.

The parties desired that a consent order be entered in this case, in lieu of a hearing. There is no justiciable issue for hearing and determination at this time. Both parties agree that a consent order is appropriate, and a formal hearing is unnecessary to resolve the contested case dispute.
