ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE
CONSENT ORDER


Claimant Sarah Phillips sustained a work injury on October 17, 2012. On September 27, 2021, the Claimant filed a Petition for Alternate Medical Care and Defendants REM Iowa and New Hampshire Insurance Company filed an Answer on October 5, 2021. No hearing was held as the parties stipulated to the contents of the Consent Order.

Claimant seeks ongoing authorization for treatment at the University of Michigan's pain management department. Claimant does so, in part, because there is an outstanding balance at the University of Michigan in excess of \$17,000. Defendants agree the University of Michigan remains an authorized provider, and that outstanding bills for causally connected care are currently being reviewed and will be paid in a timely manner.

ORDER

Defendants REM Iowa and New Hampshire Insurance Company shall authorize payment of all outstanding balances with the University of Michigan for causally connected and authorized care and will continue to authorize the University of Michigan as a treating provider.
