Claimant filed an alternate medical care petition on August 31, 2017. Claimant's alternate care request was premised upon a request for medical care for a right knee injury sustained on August 29, 2016. Prior to hearing, the parties reached an agreement for a consent order, indicating that the parties agree to a repeat evaluation of claimant's right knee.

Given that there are no factual or legal disputes to be decided, the undersigned finds sufficient reason to issue a consent order rather than proceed with a formal evidentiary hearing. Both parties have consented to entry of this order.

ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Defendants shall authorize and provide a repeat evaluation of claimant's right knee.

Defendants shall schedule an appointment with an authorized physician within ten (10) days of this order and request the earliest available date for claimant's treatment. If such physician declines to accept claimant as a patient, defendants will authorize another physician.
