Claimant Esso Tchatchareleba filed a petition for alternate medical care seeking authorization for physical therapy recommended by the authorized treating physician, Jeffrey Nassif, M.D. An alternate care hearing was scheduled for July 13, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. At the time of the scheduled hearing attorney Andrew Giller appeared on behalf of the claimant. Attorney Steven Durick appeared on behalf of the defendant, Whirlpool Amana Division. At the start of the hearing the defendant reported it had agreed to authorize the physical therapy, and agreed to the entry of this consent order.

Therefore, upon agreement of the parties, the defendant is ordered to provide the care requested in the petition for alternate medical care filed on June 30, 2017, namely the physical therapy ordered by Dr. Nassif, and shall identify a provider by July 15, 2017.
