CONSENT ORDER REGARDING
ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

This is a contested case concerning alternate medical care, proceeding under Iowa Code chapters 85 and 17A. The expedited procedure of rule 876 Iowa Administrative Code 4.48 is invoked by claimant, Lisa Turner. Prior to proceeding with the alternate medical care claim on November 20, 2023, the undersigned spoke to the parties on the phone. The parties indicated a desire to enter into a consent order.

The defendants consent, stipulate, and agree to authorize an evaluation with On With Life. The defendants agreed to authorize and schedule the appointment before December 1, 2023. The actual appointment may occur after December 1, 2023.

The parties proposed that the undersigned issue this consent order in lieu of a formal decision. All parties consented to the entry of a consent order verbally on November 20, 2023; thus no alternate medical care decision will be issued.


ORDER
