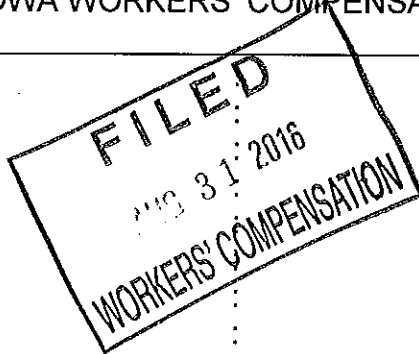

ORDER

NUNC PRO TUNC

An application for an order nunc pro tunc was filed by the defendants on an arbitration decision issued on April 29, 2016.

The motion points out that the order orders healing period benefits from February 17, 2014 through August 6, 2014 when healing benefits were stipulated as paid through March 24, 2014.

The decision correctly points out that healing period benefits owed through March 24, 2014 had been paid and gives the defendants credit for benefits previously paid. It is perhaps clearer though to change the order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the first order be changed to state, "That the defendants shall pay healing period benefits from March 25, 2014 through August 6, 2014 at the weekly rate of seven hundred two and 47/100 dollars (\$702.47)."
