ORDER


NUNC PRO TUNC

A motion for order nunc pro tunc was filed by the defendants on March 23, 2015 from an arbitration decision dated March 20, 2015.

The motion points out that on page four of the decision that a 10 percent permanent partial industrial disability equated to one hundred (100) weeks of permanent partial industrial disability when it should be fifty (50) weeks.

IT IS ORDERED that all references to one hundred (100) weeks in the decision be changed to fifty (50) weeks.
