ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

CONSENT ORDER

Claimant filed a petition seeking alternate medical care. A telephonic hearing on this petition was scheduled for December 21, 2022. Prior to the commencement of the alternate medical care hearing, the parties notified the undersigned that they had reached an amicable agreement and that an evidentiary hearing was not necessary.

Specifically, defendants agree they will promptly set up and authorize an EMG study for the claimant's left arm and wrist. I accept the parties' stipulation and agreement and find it to be a reasonable resolution of this alternate medical care claim.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties, defendants shall promptly set up and authorize an EMG study for the claimant's left arm and wrist.

The alternate medical care hearing scheduled for December 21, 2022 is cancelled.
