ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

CONSENT ORDER

On March 25, 2021, claimant filed an application for alternate medical care. On April 6, 2021, defendant filed an answer. The matter was scheduled for hearing on April 7, 2021.

Prior to the hearing, the parties confirmed that an agreement had been reached wherein defendant agreed to refer claimant to an appropriate provider for evaluation and treatment related to the claimed mental health sequelae. Defendant is currently working to secure an appointment. The parties reported that the agreement resolves the pending alternate medical care petition and requested entry of a consent order to confirm and document the agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The hearing scheduled for April 7, 2021, at 10:30 a.m. is cancelled.

Defendant agreed to provide a referral to an appropriate provider for evaluation and treatment related to the claimed mental health sequelae.

Defendant shall continue to make all reasonable efforts to schedule an appointment for claimant as soon as possible.

Defendant will provide an update to claimant within 14 days of the date of this order, providing the date of the appointment, or an update as to the progress in securing an appointment.
