ALTERNATE MEDICAL
CARE CONSENT ORDER

HEAD NOTE NO: 2701

Claimant filed an application for alternate medical care on or about August 6, 2019, seeking authorization for mental health treatment ordered in a previous arbitration decision. The matter was scheduled for hearing on August 19, 2019.


At the commencement of hearing, the parties contacted the undersigned Deputy and indicated that defendants have agreed to authorize the treatment in question. Claimant's specific requested relief is authorization of ongoing mental health treatment, including individual therapy, with Dr. Stephen Holbrook, Psy.D., at the Mason City VA, and ongoing mental health treatment, including recommended prescription medication, with Dr. Rogerio Ramos, M.D., at the Mason City VA. Defendants agree to authorize ongoing care with Dr. Holbrook and Dr. Ramos.

A hearing is therefore determined to be unnecessary, based on the agreement of the parties.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

The claimant's petition for alternate medical care is GRANTED. Defendants shall immediately authorize treatment as set forth above.
