
On April 26, 2019, claimant filed a petition for alternate medical care. The matter was scheduled for hearing on May 7, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. On May 6, 2019, defendants filed an answer indicating they had authorized the care being sought by claimant—an MRI—but the MRI had not yet been scheduled due to a miscommunication.

On May 7, 2019, prior to going on the record, the parties indicated to the undersigned that they had reached an agreement that resolves the pending alternate medical care matter. They requested entry of a consent order to confirm and document the agreement.

Defendants agree to provide the authorized care requested in claimant's alternate medical care petition.
