## BEFORE THE IOWA WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSIONER

On April 21, 2004, claimant filed an application for alternate medical care under lowa Code section 85.27 and rule 876 IAC 4.48. A hearing was held on May 3, 2004. All parties were given proper notice.

Claimant sustained an injury on December 31, 2003, which arose out of and in the course of employment. Claimant is dissatisfied with the medical treatment offered by the defendants.

The hearing was recorded via an audiotape, and a complete decision was dictated into the record on the day of the hearing. The decision will be reproduced in typewritten form only if the decision is appealed, and the parties are advised to follow the procedures outlined under the administrative code. Any rights of appeal will run from the date the decision was dictated into the record May 3, 2004.

The deputy ordered that claimant's petition for alternate medical care be granted. Defendants were ordered to provide surgery by a doctor chosen by defendants. The decision was rendered May 3, 2004.

Pursuant to a standing order of delegation of authority by the workers' compensation commissioner pursuant to Iowa Code section 86.3, the undersigned enters this decision for the workers' compensation commissioner. There is no right of appeal of this decision to the workers' compensation commissioner. Appeal of this decision, if any, would be by judicial review pursuant to Iowa Code section 17A.19.
