CONSENT ORDER

This is a contested case concerning alternate medical care, proceeding under Iowa Code chapters 85 and 17A. The expedited procedure of rule 876 Iowa Administrative Code 4.48 is invoked by claimant, Areej Alebeed. The alternate medical care claim proceeded with a telephone hearing on August 24, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.

After discussing their positions, and a recently received x-ray report, the parties discussed the entry of a consent order in this matter. The defendants consent, stipulate, and agree to send the right shoulder x-ray report dated July 30, 2022, to a mutually agreed upon orthopedic provider.


