CONSENT ORDER


On May 22, 2023, claimant filed a petition for alternate medical care. Defendants filed an answer on June 1, 2023, admitting liability for the claim. Hearing was scheduled to take place on June 2, 2023.

Prior to the time of hearing, the parties contacted the undersigned and indicated they had reached an agreement regarding the requested care. Given the agreement of the parties, the hearing was determined to be unnecessary. The parties requested entry of a consent order to confirm and document the agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Within 10 days of the date of this order, defendants will pay any outstanding balances owed for claimant's past treatment at Pain Specialists of Iowa. Additionally, within 10 days of the date of this order, defendants will authorize, make payment arrangements, and schedule an appointment for pain management at Pain Specialists of Iowa for claimant's cervical spine injury and related musculoskeletal pain.
