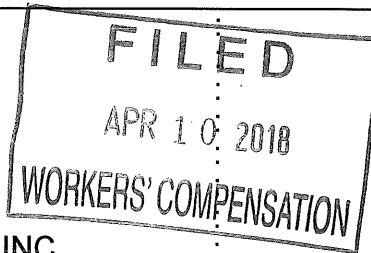

ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE
CONSENT ORDER

Claimant filed a Petition for Alternate Medical Care on March 28, 2018, against The Wittern Group and Chubb Group of Insurance Companies, its insurance carrier. Claimant sought authorization for medical care. A hearing was scheduled for April 10, 2018.


Immediately prior to hearing, defendants agreed to provide treatment to the claimant. Prior to going on the record, counsel for the parties agreed that the treatment offered by the defendants was sufficient.

A hearing was determined to be unnecessary. Defendants have agreed to authorize pain management treatment as recommended by Kurt Smith, D.O. It was represented to the undersigned that defendants have already begun working on arranging an appointment for this.
