CONSENT ORDER REGARDING

ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

Claimant filed an application for alternate medical care on March 20, 2023, requesting defendants be ordered to authorize a neurosurgical evaluation for his cervical spine condition at either the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics or Mayo Clinic. A telephonic hearing on this petition was scheduled to occur on March 31, 2023, at 10:30 AM.

Prior to hearing, the parties contacted the undersigned and indicated defendants provided written authorization for a neurosurgical referral request to the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, which is currently pending review therewith.


Claimant desired that a Consent Order be entered in this case, in lieu of a hearing. Given defendants' agreement to provide the requested care, there is no justiciable issue for hearing and determination. Both parties agree that a consent order is appropriate and a formal hearing is unnecessary to resolve the contested case dispute.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Defendants shall obtain confirmation from the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics as to its decision on acceptance of the referral within a reasonable time from this order, not to exceed 30 days.
