Claimant filed an application for alternate medical care on March 20, 2023, requesting defendants be ordered to authorize a neurosurgical evaluation for his cervical spine condition at either the University of lowa Hospitals and Clinics or Mayo Clinic. A telephonic hearing on this petition was scheduled to occur on March 31, 2023, at 10:30 AM.

Prior to hearing, the parties contacted the undersigned and indicated defendants provided written authorization for a neurosurgical referral request to the University of lowa Hospitals and Clinics, which is currently pending review therewith.

Claimant desired that a Consent Order be entered in this case, in lieu of a hearing. Given defendants' agreement to provide the requested care, there is no justiciable issue for hearing and determination. Both parties agree that a consent order is appropriate and a formal hearing is unnecessary to resolve the contested case dispute.

Defendants shall obtain confirmation from the University of lowa Hospitals and Clinics as to its decision on acceptance of the referral within a reasonable time from this order, not to exceed 30 days.
