
With respect to the specific alternate medical care requested, defendants have agreed to authorize and arrange medical treatment for claimant at Parkview Orthopedics. Defendants are ordered to provide all pertinent records to Parkview Orthopedics as soon as possible, but in no event any later than October 7, 2022.

The parties desired that a consent order be entered in this case, in lieu of a hearing. After discussion between the parties and an agreement to provide the requested care, there is no justiciable issue for hearing and determination. Both parties agree that a consent order is appropriate and a formal hearing is unnecessary to resolve the contested case dispute.

By reaching this agreement and consenting to this order, neither party waves any rights they may have in the future to address medical treatment. Defendants maintain the right to direct medical care in this case.
