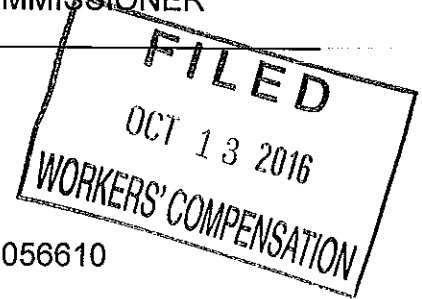

ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

CONSENT ORDER

Claimant filed a petition for alternate medical care on October 3, 2016. Defendants filed their answer on October 6, 2016. The matter was set for telephone hearing on October 13, 2016.

At the telephone hearing, after discussion, the parties reached a resolution by consent. Defendants confirmed that, at this time, therapist Pam Little and physician, Dr. Mahoney, remain authorized treating medical providers for claimant concerning the work in jury of July 28, 2015. Claimant confirmed that this understanding satisfied the present concerns regarding medical care. By reaching this agreement and consenting to this order, neither party waves any rights they may have in the future to address medical treatment.
