CONSENT ORDER

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This is a contested case concerning alternate medical care, proceeding under Iowa Code chapters 85 and 17A. The expedited procedure of rule 876 IAC 4.48 is invoked by claimant, Janet Marshall. The alternate medical care claim was scheduled for telephone hearing on May 17, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.

Prior to the commencement of the hearing, on May 16, 2022, the parties and the undersigned discussed the entry of a consent order in this matter. The defendants consent, stipulate, and agree to authorize Dr. Hussain at ORA for causally related and medically necessary and reasonable treatment of the claimant's left hip and left hand/wrist, as determined by Dr. Hussain.


The parties proposed that the undersigned issue this consent order in lieu of a formal hearing. All parties consented to the entry of a consent order via e-mail on May 16, 2022; thus, no alternate medical care hearing is necessary.
