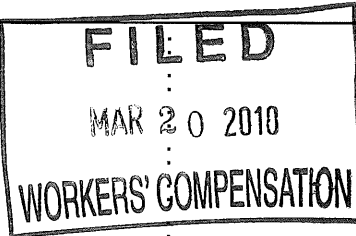

CONSENT ORDER FOR
ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

On March 8, 2018 claimant filed a petition in this matter. On March 16, 2018 defendants filed an answer. Both parties submitted exhibits. A hearing was held in this matter on March 20, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. as scheduled.


After hearing and the taking of testimony, counsel for both parties spoke on the phone and decided there was an agreement on all issues, and that a consent order could be issued in this matter.

Defendants have agreed to timely authorize all prescriptions from authorized providers. Defendants have agreed to authorize the requested knee brace. Defendants have agreed to pay for claimant's prior appointment at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics (UIHC) Pain Management Clinic. Defendants have agreed to authorize claimant's injections at the UIHC on March 21, 2018. Claimant will agree to transfer her care to Des Moines Orthopedic Surgeons (DMOS) after she receives the injections at the UIHC on March 21, 2018.

Counsel for the parties are respectfully requested to communicate with one another in the future, prior to hearings, rather than waste this agency's time in proceeding with an unnecessary hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the parties have consented to resolution of the petition for alternate medical care as detailed above.
