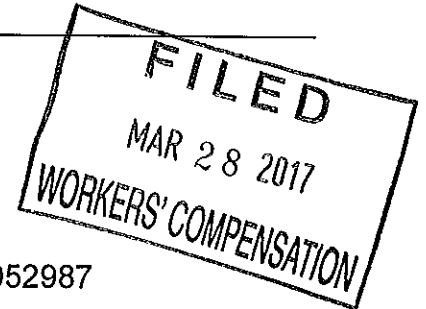

MEMORANDUM DECISION
ON ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

An original notice and petition seeking alternate medical care was filed by claimant under administrative rule 876 IAC 4.48. A telephonic hearing on this petition was held on March 27, 2017. All parties were given proper notice and were aware that the undersigned has been delegated final agency decision authority in this proceeding.

The entire hearing was recorded by digital tape. A detailed decision containing findings of fact and conclusions of law was dictated into the record on the date of the hearing.
