The defendants are specifically ordered to authorize and pay for the claimant to undergo a spinal cord stimulator trial, which will be performed by authorized treating provider Dr. Timothy Miller. COX V. SILENT THUNDER, INC. Page 2

The defendants are also ordered to authorize and pay for any and all medical care and expenses related to the spinal cord stimulator trial, including, but not limited to, a pre-trial psychological evaluation.
