ORDER OF CONSENT RE:

ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

The parties previously entered into a consent order in File Number 22009139.02 in which defendants agreed as follows:

Within 14 days of the date of this order, the defendants shall contact a physician to schedule an appointment with a pain management specialist for Erlandson's right shoulder and right arm. The appointment need not occur within 14 days of this order.

Defendants authorized an appointment with Dr. Timothy Miller in Dubuque, Iowa.

Subsequently, claimant filed an original notice and petition concerning alternate medical care on November 20, 2023, requesting that the defendants be ordered to authorize pain management treatment with a provider in Waterloo, Iowa. Prior to the hearing, the defendants authorized Allen Center for Pain Medicine to provide care.

Claimant expressed a desire for entry of a consent order rather than a hearing.

A hearing is therefore unnecessary, based upon the agreement of the parties.


ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

The defendants shall contact a physician to schedule an appointment with a pain management specialist at Allen Center for Pain Medicine for claimant's right shoulder and right arm within 14 days of the date of this order.

The appointment need not occur within 14 days of this order, but defendants will contact a physician to schedule an appointment within 14 days.
