Claimant filed an application for alternate medical care on August 17, 2022 requesting that defendants be ordered to authorize treatment for her cervical spine injury. On August 27, 2022, defendants filed an answer indicating they agree to the care recommended by claimant's ARNP, have provided prescription coverage, and are working to set up the recommended treatments.

Hearing was scheduled for August 29, 2022. The parties desired that a Consent Order be entered in this case, in lieu of a hearing. The parties agree that defendants will authorize and pay for claimant to attend physical therapy, massage therapy, continued counseling, prescription medications, and continued treatment and medication management through Brandi Booth, ARNP. A hearing is therefore determined to be unnecessary, based on the agreement of the parties.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Defendants shall promptly authorize and arrange to pay for physical therapy with a provider of their choosing; massage therapy with a provider of their choosing; continued counseling with Rhonda Thompson, LISW; prescription medications (Meloxicam, Robaxin, BusPirone, and Venlafaxine); and continued treatment and medication management through Brandi Booth, ARNP, as the authorized treating provider.
