CONSENT ORDER

On November 25, 2020, claimant filed a petition for alternate medical care. The matter was scheduled for hearing on December 10, 2020. Joseph Powell appeared for claimant and Lindsey Mills appeared for defendants.

At the time of the hearing, the parties confirmed that an agreement had been reached wherein defendants have agreed to provide medical treatment for claimant's work injury. The parties reported that the agreement resolves the pending alternate medical care petition and requested entry of a consent order to confirm and document the agreement.

The defendants have authorized Kyle Galles, M.D., to provide a second opinion and possible treatment pursuant to Iowa Code section 85.27 regarding the claimant's left shoulder.
