CONSENT ORDER

This is a contested case concerning alternate medical care, proceeding under Iowa Code chapters 85 and 17A. The expedited procedure of rule 876 IAC 4.48 is invoked by claimant, Greg Wolf. The alternate medical care claim was scheduled for telephone hearing on June 13, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.

On June 10, 2022, the parties and the undersigned discussed the entry of a consent order in this matter. The defendants consent, stipulate, and agree to authorize a medication consult with either Mr. Wolf's primary care provider or another medical practitioner.


