ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE  
CONSENT ORDER

This is a contested case concerning alternate medical care, proceeding under Iowa Code chapters 85 and 17A. The expedited procedure of rule 876 Iowa Administrative Code 4.48 is invoked by claimant, Joy Rankin. The alternate medical care claim proceeded with a telephone hearing on October 4, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.


