CONSENT ORDER

RE: ALTERNATE MEDICAL CARE

Claimant filed the above-captioned applications for alternate medical care on September 25, 2023, requesting that Defendant be ordered to authorize evaluation and treatment of Claimant's right shoulder, right arm, left shoulder, neck, head, left arm, left hand, and left third finger.
