
Claimant filed a petition for alternate medical care on January 17, 2019. Defendants filed an appearance on January 21, 2019. The matter was scheduled for telephone hearing on January 31, 2019 at 10:30 a.m.

At the commencement of hearing, defendants admitted liability for claimant's claim and the parties reached a resolution of the petition by consent. Specifically, defendants have authorized shoulder surgery and, as no surgery date was confirmed as of the date of hearing, further agree that a surgery date will be obtained within the next 30 days. The parties agreed to the undersigned issuing this consent order confirming the agreement reached.

By reaching this agreement and consenting to this order, neither party waives any rights they may have in the future to address medical treatment.
