
BEFORE THE IOWA WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSIONER



On May 7, 2018, claimant filed an application for alternate medical care under lowa Code section 85.27 and rule 876 IAC 4.48. A hearing was held on May 17, 2018. All parties were given proper notice.

Claimant sustained an injury on February 10, 2018, which arose out of and in the course of employment. Claimant is dissatisfied with the medical treatment offered by the defendants.

The hearing was recorded via digital voice recorder and a complete decision was dictated into the record on the day of the hearing. The decision will be reproduced in typewritten form only if the decision is appealed, and the parties are advised to follow the procedures outlined under the administrative code. Any rights of appeal will run from the date the decision was dictated into the record.

The deputy ordered that claimant's petition for alternate medical care be denied. The decision was rendered orally on May 17, 2018.
